

Redeeming Joy program was developed with the survivor in mind and with the knowledge that it takes a wide range of services to help each survivor obtain and maintain self-sufficient free and whole living.

We also understand that each survivor has her own set of needs and therefore accommodate accordingly. Each service or support is designed to help promote empowerment of each survivor helping her to see her value, worth and ability to set goals and see them achieved.




